Important Notes:

- The student is eligible for availing only one scholarship/concession at one time.
- For availing any of the mentioned scholarship/concessions, the student must give his/her application in the name of the Director/Principal/ Dean along with relevant documents.
- Entry level scholarship/concessions will be limited to tuition fee payable at entry level (1st Semester) Only.
- All given scholarship/concessions valid only for Indian Nationals.
- All given scholarship/concessions valid only for students of batch 2019.

Requirement : Copy of the University/Board Merit List

***Note:** In case of Rayat-Bahra University & Bahra University the concession will be valid if student secures 1 to 3 positions in the University examination and CGPA/SGPA is > 9.0

***Note:** The above said concession will be valid for a semester only if the student secures 1 to 10 positions as stated in one semester of the academic session.

In case the student secures position as stated above in both the semesters/annual examination, the concession will be valid for one year and shall be adjusted along with the tuition fee of next semester/year of the respected class. However, in case of final year students, the concession shall be adjusted in the tuition fee of the last semester only.

C. Scheme of Post Matric Scholarships to the students belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes (Govt. Scheme)

Objective: The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the Scheduled Caste students studying at post matriculation or post-secondary stage to enable them to complete their education.

Scheme: Scholarships will be paid to the students whose parents/guardians' income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees 2.5 lakh only) per annum.



STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS

Disciplinary Rules & Regulations for Students

- Students are expected to maintain decorum in their behavior and habits, at all times, befitting the prestige of the Professional Program.
- Students are also expected to dress-up decently in all public places.
- Students are advised to attend all classes and to ensure that they maintain the attendance criteria as laid down by the university ordinance governing the same.
- Participation of students in academic activities such as seminar/workshop, industrial visits is compulsory.
- If a student absents from the classes for seven consecutive working days without prior permission his/her name may be struck off the rolls.
- During the teaching hours students are not allowed to leave the campus without written permission from the Campus authorities.
- Students are prohibited from engaging in acts of intimidation, violence or abuse against any of the students, employees, staff and faculty members of the campus.
- Students are expected to show sincere, decent and cordial attitude towards their classmates, students of other programs, staff, faculty and other employees of the campus.
- Loitering in the campus is prohibited.
- Smoking, chewing pan, Pan-masala, gutka, gambling, consumption of alcoholic drinks and use of hallucinogenic drugs and other illegal substances, or the possession of such substances, anywhere in the Campus, is strictly forbidden.
- Carrying any explosive/fire arm, and/or weapon inside the campus is strictly prohibited.
- Students are advised not to indulge in any prohibited, illegal and unethical, immoral activities inside and/or outside the Campus, or else, they will be liable for punishment as per campus rules.
- Safety of all personal valuables/belongings will be the responsibility of the student.
- If the student is found involved in activities resulting in direct or indirect loss/damage to the Group, the same shall be borne by the student. He/She will be asked to compensate the Campus for the same.
- Adherence to dress code is compulsory for academic and allied activities in the campus.
- Each student will be issued an identity card which is non-transferrable. Student is expected to carry the ID card on his/her person while in the Campus and especially when appearing in tests and examinations, etc. and also when going out of the Campus.
- Campus would not be liable for any compensation/claim whatsoever under any circumstances, in case of any casualty/injury or otherwise to any student during his/her academic course inside or outside the Campus.
- Competent authority of the Campus possesses the right to modify the aforesaid rules and/or insert/delete from time to time in future and the same shall be binding upon the students.

Zero Tolerance Towards Ragging

Ragging is an inhuman act and is banned both inside and outside the campuses. The Honorable Supreme Court of India has taken serious cognizance of the offence of ragging and has issued strict directives for steps to ensure its elimination. Students shall not directly or indirectly indulge in, aid or abet any activity that might be constructed as ragging. Violators will face necessary disciplinary and legal action. This includes lodging of a criminal case, against the students at the Police Station as per the directive of the Honourable Supreme Court of India as well as expulsion from the University. (For details, refer to anti-ragging policy of the Group available at group website)

Supreme Court Definition of Ragging

“Ragging is any disorderly conduct, whether by words spoken or written, or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any student, indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities which cause or are likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the psyche of a fresher or a junior student.”

In case of any dispute on any matter, the decision of the Group/Campus would be final and binding.

Students Information, Care and Counselling Cell (SIC)

RBU Hostel Policy, Rules and Code of Conduct For Hostellers


Rayat Bahra University (RBU), Mohali offers hostel facility for students with the primary objective of instilling in every hosteller a spirit of bonhomie, self-confidence and self-discipline. Hostel accommodation, separately for boys and girls, will be provided by the University solely based on availability on first come first serve basis.

1. Hostel Authorities

Chief Wardens, wardens, assistant wardens would reside in the hostel premises. They would be responsible for the day-to-day operations and administration of all hostels. Responsibilities, roles and the powers of each of these authorities will be notified to the hostellers, as applicable.

2. Hostel Admission

- 2.1. Students seeking admission to the University hostels must apply for the same at the time of admission to the University. Hostel room is allotted for a whole year and students are not allowed to vacate the hostels during mid year. The student must pay the hostel fee as prescribed by the University (charged annually) and is non refundable. At the time of the hostel room allocation, the students should produce the University fee and hostel fee receipts to the concerned hostel authority.
- 2.2. At the time of admission to the hostel, a declaration agreeing to abide by the hostel policy, rules and code of conduct for hostellers as may be notified from time to time shall be signed by the student and countersigned by his/her parent(s)/legal guardian.
- 2.3. On admission, the student will be allotted a room / space which will be invariably shared by three (03) students. These allotments can undergo change at any time, for administrative or other reasons considered appropriate by the University.



3. Furniture & Fixtures

- 3.1. On allocation of the hostel room, the hostellers will be provided with the essential furniture i.e. bed, cupboard, study table, study chair and fixtures. The students should ensure that such furniture and fixtures are maintained in good condition.
- 3.2. Hostellers are required to hand over furniture and other materials in good condition when they change/vacate the hostel room failing which the concerned student/s will be charged for the damaged furniture/materials which may be recovered from the student.

4. Mess Rules

- 4.1. Parents/authorized local guardians can avail mess facility with prior information on payment basis.
- 4.2. Mess timings are as following:
- **Meal:** Summer/ Winter Timings
- Breakfast 07:30 AM to 8:45 AM
- Lunch 12:30 PM to 2:00 PM
- Evening Tea 05:00 PM to 5:30 PM
- Dinner 07:30 PM to 8:45 PM
- *These timings are subject to change by the administration.

5. Hostel Attendance Rules (girls)

- 5.1. All hostellers should report to hostel daily before 06:30 pm.
- 5.2. Attendance will be taken from 06:30 pm to 7:00 pm in summers (1st April to 30th Sep.) and from 06:00 pm to 6:30 pm in winters (1st Oct. to 31st March).
- *These timings are subject to change, if any, by the administration.

6. Hostel Attendance Rules (boys)

- 6.1. All hostellers should report to hostel daily before 09:00 pm.
- 6.2. Attendance will be taken from 09:00 pm to 9:30 pm in summers (1st April to 30th Sep.) as well as in winters (1st Oct. to 31st March) also.
- *These timings are subject to change, if any, by the administration.

7. Parents / Visitors

- 7.1. No parent / guardian / authorised visitor or any person is allowed to stay with the hostellers in their rooms.
- 7.2. No girls are permitted in the boys hostels and no boys are permitted in the girls hostels.
- 7.3. No outsider shall be allowed to stay in the Hostel. If any hosteller keep any outsider with him/her, she/he may be fined Rs. 5000/- or may be expelled from the hostel.

8. Celebration of Festivals and Birthdays

- No student/ Hosteller will be allowed to bring Cakes, Firecrackers or any other article to celebrate the event or festival in the Hostel. The Violators will be fined up to Rs. 5000/- or may be expelled from the Hostel.

9. Medical Emergency

- 9.1. Any accidents or sudden illness should be reported immediately to the concerned hostel authority for necessary action.
- In case of a medical emergency, the hosteller will be given first aid medical care and parents/guardians will be informed immediately. Hence, it is very important that the phone/contact numbers must to be updated by the hostellers/parents. The University will take all precautions in providing first aid medical care within the University hostel, and if required, the concerned hosteller may be moved to a local hospital for medical treatment and hospitalization. However, the expenses of hospitalization and other medical care given to the student will be borne by the student/ parents. The University shall not be responsible for any incident or consequence during the provision of this service. Further, the University shall not be responsible in cases of any medical exigencies such as accidents, which may occur inside the hostel premises and journeys to and from the University, including University transport facility.

Share your problem(s) individually with the authorities.	Use of sound system with speakers, or any other type of electrical and electronic appliances/gadgets in the hostel premises.
Keep your valuables and cash under lock.	Use of individual heaters, coils and iron boxes or any other heating/cooking, electrical gadgets in the room.
Save electricity and water.	Wastage of food.
Switch off the fans and lights whenever you leave hostel room.	Loiter in the hostel corridors.

1. Strictly Prohibited Activities

- Infringement of the following rules will be severely dealt with, which includes expulsion from the hostels:
 - 1.1. Ragging in any form is banned inside and outside the hostel premises. Strict action will be taken against defaulters as per the law.
 - 1.2. No leniency will be shown to offenders. Students involved in ragging will be expelled from the hostels and rusticated from the University.
 - 1.3. Consumption/possession of alcohol, smoking or use of tobacco, narcotic drugs, possession of obscene pictures, posters, pornographic materials, lethal weapons or inflammable materials and the related products are strictly banned in the hostel and University premises. Violation of these rules will be treated as a serious offence resulting in expulsion from the hostels.

2. Grievance

- If any hosteller has any grievance/problem, he/she needs to enter the grievance/complaint in the relevant "Grievance Redressal Book" kept in the respective hostel office. If the complaint is not attended to within a week, then he/she may take the issue to the concerned hostel authority. If the problem still remains un-resolved, he/she can report the grievance/complaint to the Director Administration, if required with a copy to Dean, Student Welfare.

3. Expulsion From the Hostel

- The University reserves the right to cancel admission of a hosteller, if found guilty of violating any University rules, from the University hostels without giving any prior notice or reason. Suspension/rustication from the University also implies consequent suspension/rustication from the University hostel.

4. Revisions of Rules and Regulations

- The University reserves the right to revise or amend the hostel policy, rules and code of conduct for hostellers from time to time as considered necessary by the University.
