Initiatives: Free Health Check-up Camps, Free Education, Social Contributions

Rayat Bahra University, in accordance with its tradition of giving back to society, has organized "Free Dental Checkups and Free Health Camps" throughout the countryside as well as schools, colleges, orphanages or senior care homes. Rayat Bahra University's mobile dental van provides free dental services for the benefit of society. Rayat Bahra University has adopted many villages as part of the neighboring villages program and is setting standards by providing free medical care, legal assistance, educational assistance, free access to the university library, and faculty support to nearby towns.

Objectives:

- 1 .To provide free assistance to people who are poor in the countryside, suburbs or cities because of issues such as health, finances, environment and so on. Support mergers and alliances in order to increase the ability to provide a wider range of vital services.
2. To promote cooperation amongst people, teams, and organizations in order to increase concentration and move their goals closer to realization.
4. To encourage students to take on democratic leadership roles by involving them in neighborhood initiatives.

Evidence of Success:

The institution has partnered with special schools in the surrounding regions to guarantee that students may receive a free education. The University has signed MOU with Indian Red Cross Society and other companies.

1. By participating in the Neighborhood Schooling Programme (NSP), the University is able to offer its students a wide range of education services, faculty assistance, access to university libraries and legal support. A mobile lab van equipped with a physics and chemistry lab, as well as a van for dental checkups.
2. To start the vital neighborhood changes required to eradicate social problems.
3. To provide qualifying, deserving students with financial help and discounts.
4. To encourage neighbors and members to have a feeling of belonging and community.



5. The Educators for Social Responsibility programme at Bahra University employs a variety of strategies to advance community welfare.
6. The organization hosts free medical camps that provide access to healthcare services for the nearby areas.
7. Offers financial help to deserving students based on merit. A couple of instances include the Employee's Ward Concession, Fee Waiver to Students of Whole Rayat Bahra Group Seeking Admission in Rayat Bahra University, and Siblings (Brother/Sister) Studying in Rayat Bahra Group.

Blood Donation Camp

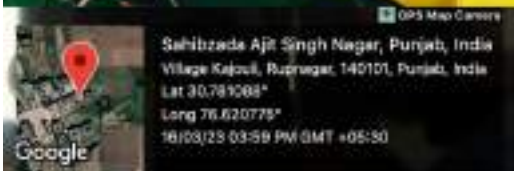

The University School of Medical and Allied Sciences of the Rayat Bahra University organized a blood donation camp in memory of sacrifices made by Shaheed Bhagat Singh, Rajguru and Sukhdev to help suffering patients in collaboration with Transfusion medicine, PGIMER, Chd., Punjab Red Cross and Shree Shiv Kanwar Mahasangh Charitable Trust, Panchkula. Dr Pankaj Kaul Dean USAHS said that 100 persons came forward to donate blood at the camp. Inaugurating the camp, former VC, BFUHS and Dean Medical, Prof. (Dr) S. S. Gill, said that the management of the RBU, besides focusing on academics, was concerned to the needs of the society. It was with a spirit of social services that the university decided to organize a camp to help those who needed help in their hour of difficulty.





Physiotherapy Camps

Physiotherapy Department of University School of Allied Health Sciences (USAHS), Rayat Bahra University in collaboration with Dental College Rayat Bahra University, Mohali organized a free Physiotherapy Camp at Village Kajouli, District Ropar, and Punjab on 15th March 2023. 10-15 Students and Faculty of USAHS provided free physiotherapy consultation and treatment in the camp to more than 80 patients from various parts of village Kajouli, as well as nearby villages of Punjab. Ms. Sarabjeet, Acting HOD, USAHS explained the role of physiotherapy in normal routine life of individuals to the villagers and she also informed that, in order to spread the awareness among society about rehabilitation, Physiotherapy department of USAHS RBU often organizes free Physiotherapy Camps in and around rural areas of the RBU campus. USAHS also have an OPD in Campus which offers Physiotherapy services on very minimal charges which is open for all 5 days a week.

Gurvinder Singh Bahra and guidance of Vice-Chancellor, Prof. (Dr.) Parvinder Singh and convene-ship of Prof. (Dr.) Simerjit Kaur, Dean Students Welfare.

The workshop was conducted with a mission to save lives of those suffering from life threatening fatal blood disorders like Blood Cancer, Thalassemia, Leukaemia, Aplastic Anaemia, Sickle Cell Anaemia



etc. Ms. Anuradha Tandon, Senior Associate - Partnerships & Medical Affairs, DATRI foundation told that DATRI is working towards creating a wide and diverse database of potential Blood Stem Cell Donors that can be accessed by any patient, living anywhere in the world, in need of a Blood Stem Cell Transplant. She elaborated the process of blood stem cell donation and collected the swabs of the students who voluntarily registered with the Datri foundation. Vice-Chancellor Sir stated that Rayat Bahra University is committed towards the community services and this workshop is also an initiative to do something for the benefit of the society. Prof. (Dr.) Simerjit Kaur, Dean Students Welfare, highlighted the significance of the blood stem cell donation and motivated the young minds to be life savers. At the end of the session, students interacted with the expert & got themselves registered for the noble cause.
